LANGUAGE LABORATORY ACTIVITIES – 2016-17

The language laboratory, an audio-visual installation is used as an aid in modern language teaching. The laboratory had adequate software to help students' hone their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. As it is a technological aid for learning, it has a number of advanced facilities that helped the student to learn a language with proficiency to communicate.

The following activities had taken place in the language lab to improve the communication skills of the students:

- ❖ Exercises were given to enhance the proficiency of the students in all four primary skills (LSRW) of English through communicational lab.
- ❖ Activities helped to track the progress of each student and receive reports of strengths and weakness to better adapt classroom activities.
- ❖ Classroom etiquette, giving instructions, asking questions, framing interactive questions etc. were taught to the students. This infuses confidence in them to improve competency.
- ❖ The students watched videos to practice their pronunciation through a speech recognizer; learnt new vocabulary and much more.
- ❖ Lab activities proceeds to self guided independent learning where the students could individually focus and practice on language skills.
- ❖ It helped the students to use multimedia facilities to better their language skills.
- ❖ Around 500 students from first year, 300 students from second year from various departments and 240 Students from the English department were utilizing the language laboratory.

LANGUAGE LABORATORY ACTIVITIES – 2017-18

English Language Proficiency Acquisition Platform made available in the Computer Lab in the first floor has the latest required paraphernalia like digital multimedia control, headsets, microphones, interactive response control, etc. Our Language Laboratory's collection is designed to assist learners in the acquisition and maintenance of aural comprehension, oral and written proficiency, and cultural awareness. It offers the best stuff for students to master effortlessly English pronunciation, accent, diction and conversational skill.

The Faculty Members who handle General English Class takes the students once in a month to initiate Language Lab and will have follow-up sessions on a regular basis. Around 500 students from first year and 300 students from second year from various departments were the beneficiaries. 240 Students from the English department were utilizing the language lab enable the students to learn better pronunciation through stress on word accent, intonation and rhythm which makes them to understand Phonetics paper successfully. Students were trained to use language effectively to face interview, group discussions, and public speaking. Task given in the language lab helps the students to maintain good linguistic competence- through accuracy in grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.

Our students are benefitted through Language Laboratory which acts as a platform for learning, practicing and producing language skills through interactive sessions and communicative mode of teaching. Learners can act and respond in a variety of ways at their own pace.
