Dr. (Mrs). V. Arulmozhi, Librarian, shared the significance notes about **“Vasipai Nesipom”**.

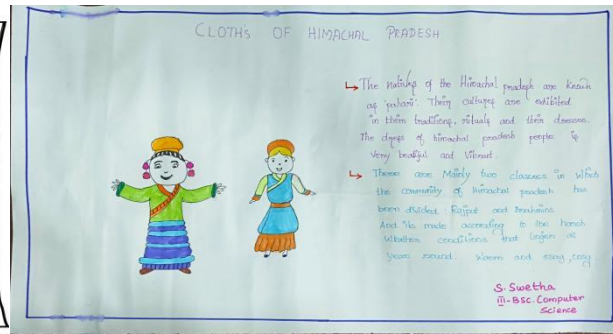

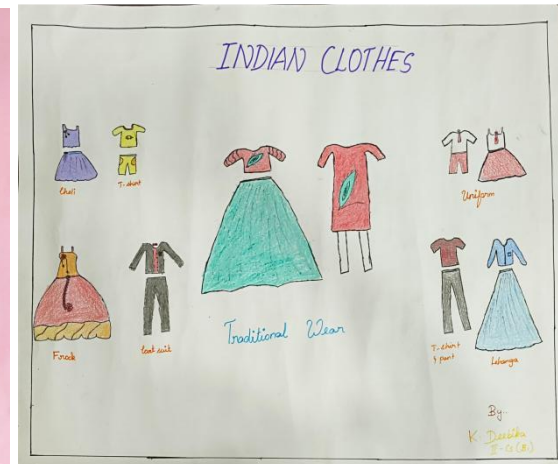

- Dhoti is a rectangular piece of unstitched cloth about 4-5 yards long wrapped around the waist and legs and tucked up to the waist. It is commonly worn in combination with a kurta top, which is a long sleeve fitting shirt.
- It is held in place by a cloth of varying width and sometimes with the help of a belt. It is made of various materials like cotton, silk, wool, and synthetic materials.

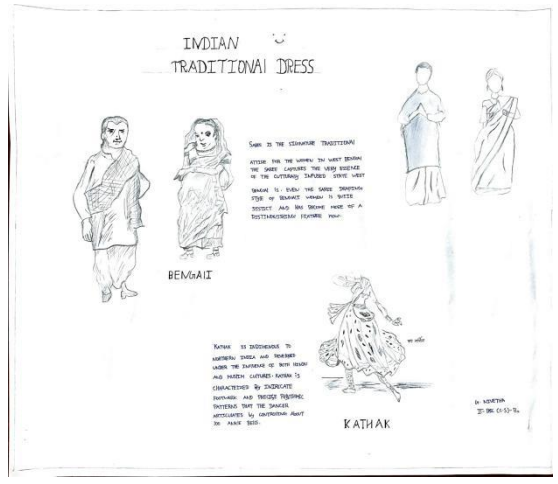
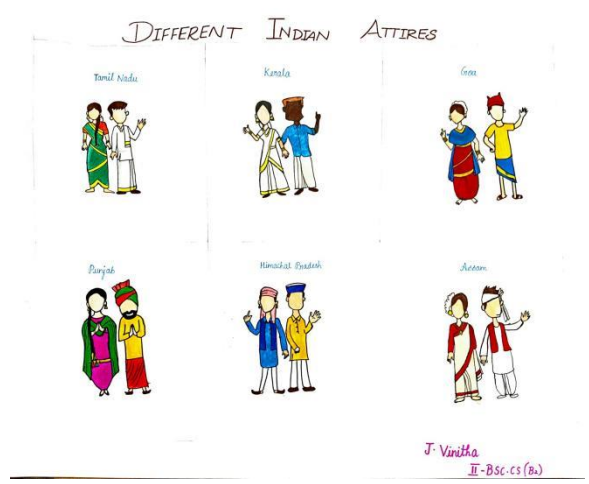
KATHAWASTI
