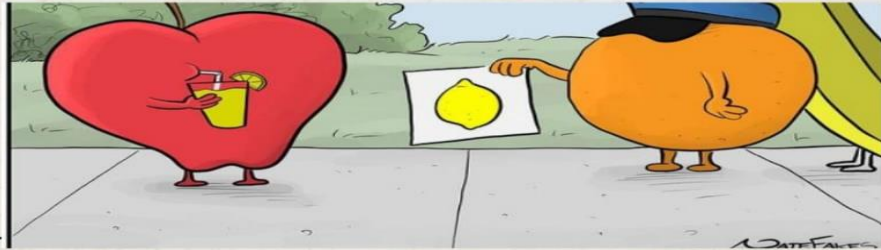

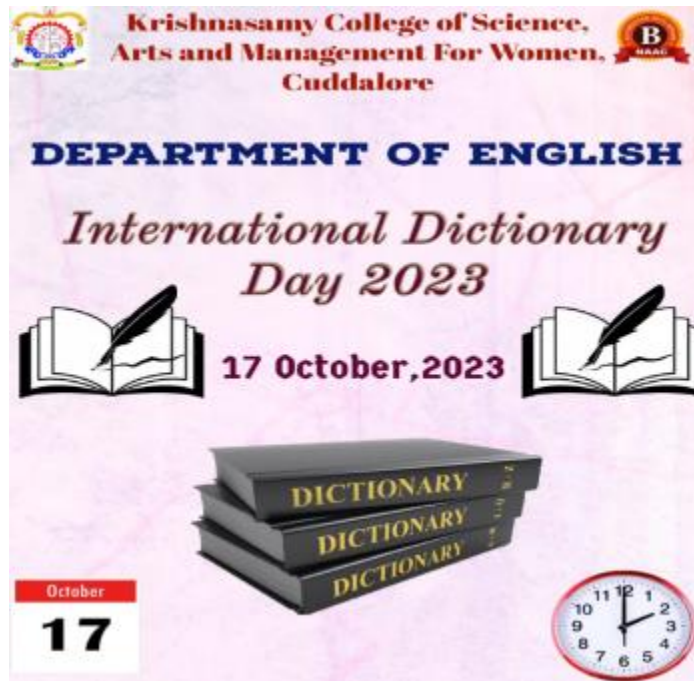

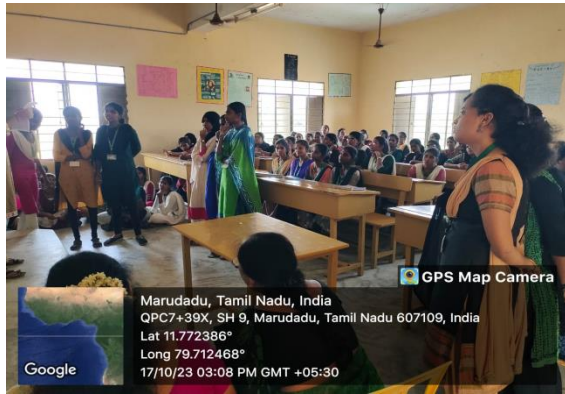
### **International Dictionary Day Report**

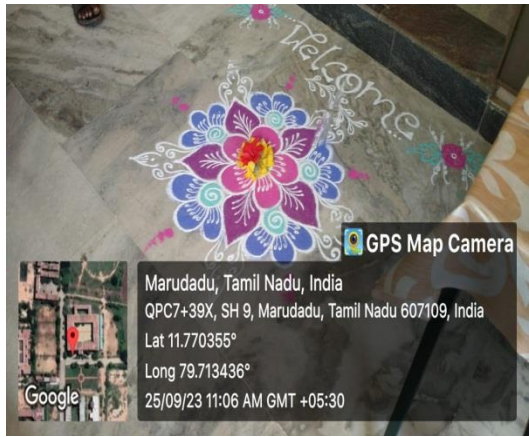

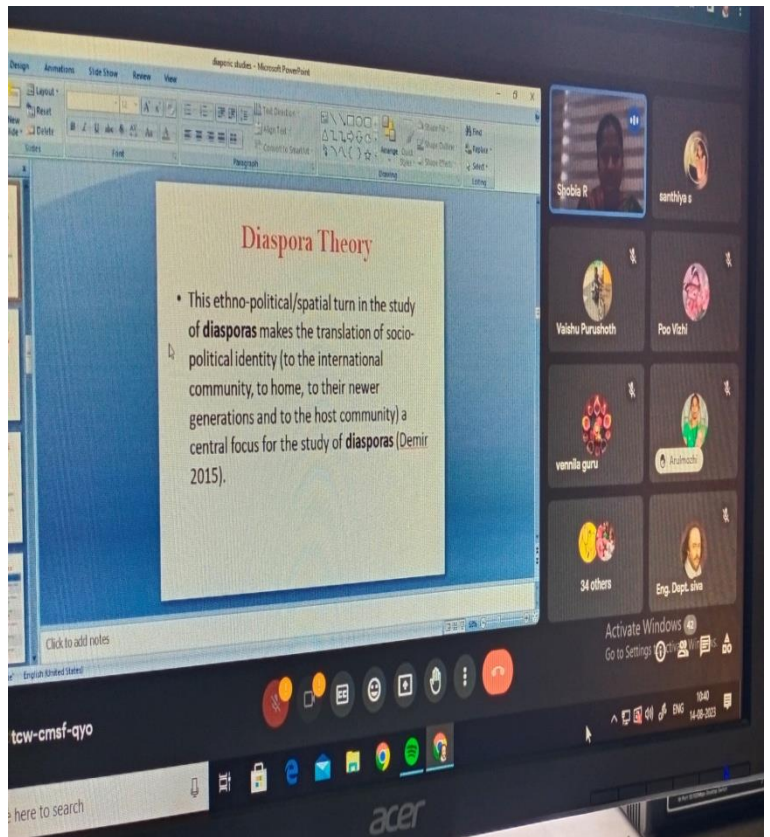
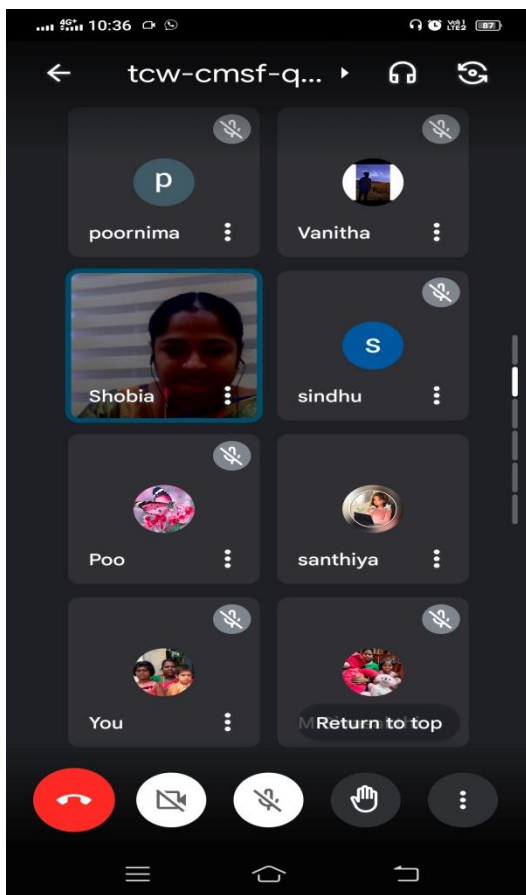

### Report of International Malala Day

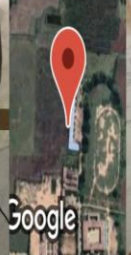

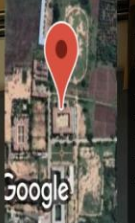
